The confusion is your use of the term "uniform current" eg pm 1 17, p2, 1 15 p3, and Figure 4 caption. For most readers, "uniform current" means constant in both vertical and horizontal. This is not what you mean, and so a different phrase is needed.

Now we have changed the confusing definition to 'uniform current (flowing over a stationary bottom boundary)' or 'uniform mean flow (flowing over a stationary bottom boundary)'.
